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What collaborative tools do you use currently?

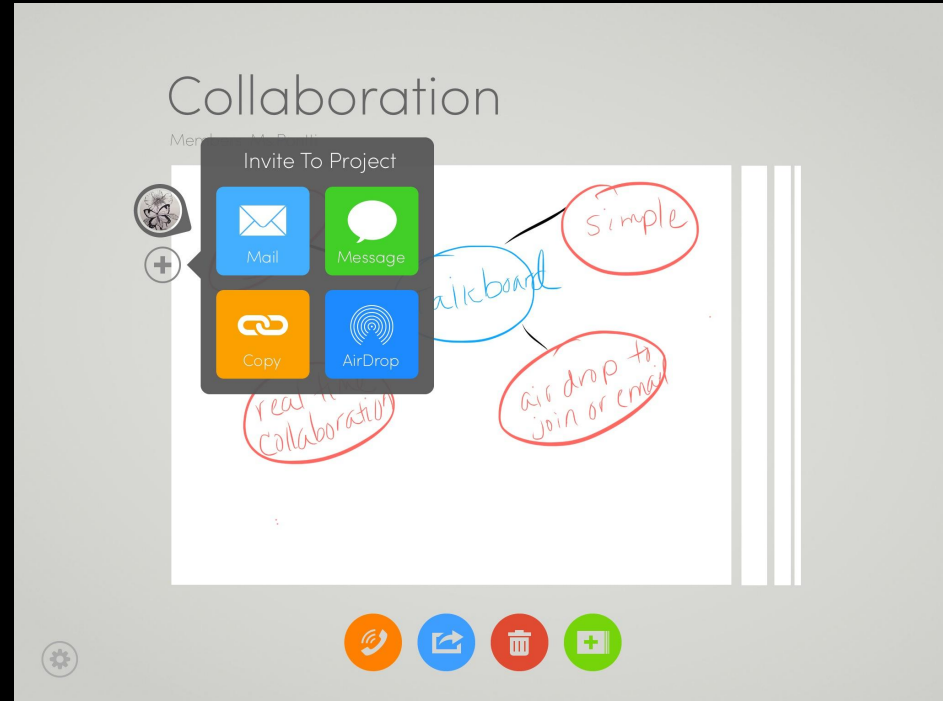
Google Docs

- Sharing allows students to collaborate on same document
- Track student contributions, changes in documents
- Sharing settings allow for small or large groups to access document

Padlet - try it at tinyurl.com/padletins

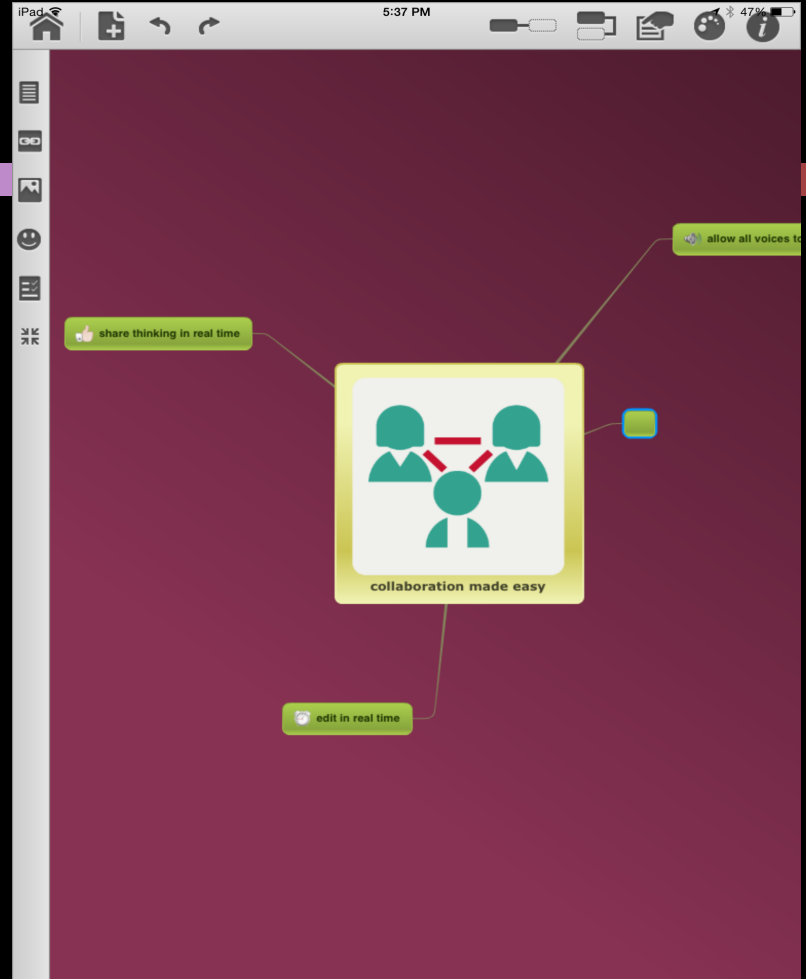
- Simultaneous access to a shared board

- Connects to your StJLabs account
